This eliminates thousands of items from the feed which are not subject to withholding tax relief procedures and instructions.

At launch-time, the new feed includes events going back to January 2010 and improved search functionality using specific data points including CUSIP, Issuer Name, Country of Issuance, Record Date and Payment Date, among others.
